The total money collected for the Boiler Replacement Project is \$49,468.90 thus far; Family of Faith \$52,372.65.

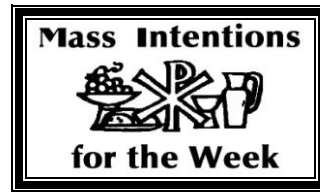
Thank you for your donations and generosity to Transfiguration of Our Lord Parish! We need \$4,908.14 to complete the project.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY 2017

Every year, between January 18 (the feast of the Confession of St. Peter) and January 25 (the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul), Christians around the world are invited to celebrate a week of prayer for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate in jointly-organized ecumenical services, and to share fellowship. This year's theme is "Reconciliation" - The Love of Christ Compels Us," inspired by 2Corinthians 5:14-20. They invite Christians around the world to celebrate God's reconciling grace, call us to recognize the pain of the deep divisions which afflict the Church, and urge us to become ambassadors of Christ's message of reconciliation.
