CHURCH PARKING LOT

The Parish Finance Council have reviewed five quotes from different paving companies and have selected the paver with the best quote to complete the asphalt paving of our parking lot this coming summer.

The cost of repaving our parking lot is approximately \$135,000.00. Unfortunately our current financial situation does not allow us to cover the entire cost. The Parish Finance Council and Fr. George have agreed that we will be asking the Archdiocese for a loan of \$142,000.00 due to the fact that we have an outstanding payment to the Archdiocese regarding the church assessment and the cost of the repaving of the parking lot.

The parish would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who contributed to the 5-year Family of Faith campaign which will be ending this Fall season. With the contributions that we have collected, we were able to use a portion of the monies towards the cost of the replacement of the boiler. The remainder will be applied to the cost of the repaving of the parking lot.

We would like to request that you continue using the blue donation envelopes that are available in the vestibule and the parish office.

As we have to pay back the loan to the Archdiocese, the council have decided that in 2020, a weekly blue church maintenance envelope will be included in the box set of donation envelopes. We would greatly appreciate your assistance and support in this matter. In addition to our weekly blue church maintenance envelopes, we will be also looking at other fundraisers to help pay off the loan.

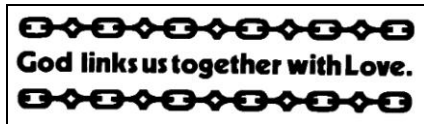

Time: 9:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

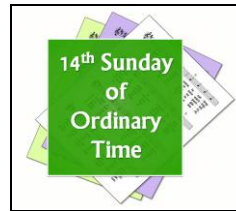

Let us welcome Fr. David E. Okenyi, C.S.Sp. this weekend of July 6th & 7th, 2019 to our parish.

Fr. David is the Director of a Catholic Religious Order called The Congregation of the Holy Ghost (Spirit) – SPIRITANS; which is an International Religious Order with its headquarters in Rome. The Congregation started in France in 1703, and today there are over three thousand members.

The Spiritans are in sixty countries and work in diverse ministries including education, parish work, refugee ministry and hospital chaplaincy. They are dedicated to working with the poor and the marginalized, and in those situations where the Church has difficulty in finding ministers. The Spiritans offer counsel and support to those who are abandoned, oppressed or excluded, especially in the third world countries, and bring the message of Christ to those who have not heard it.
