A REPORT FROM THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

In 2018 through your generosity, we were able to make 105 home visits to assist our neighbours in need. These visits helped a total of 137 adults and 190 children.

The total revenue for the year was \$25,351.04 and the expenses totalled \$24,734.78. The bulk of the expenses were primarily for food but also included clothing, furniture, prescription drugs and household items. The help with groceries is managed through vouchers which we issue, and can only be redeemed at the No Frills Store at Dixon and Islington.
