



FR. CHARLES EGBULEFU

We are excited to welcome our new associate pastor, Fr. Charles Kelechi Egbulefu C.C.E., who was born in Owerri, Imo State, Nigeria, on September 5th 1985 to Sir Hartley and Lady Victoria Egbulefu. He is the fifth of six children.

Between the age of 9 and 10 years old, Fr. Charles was called to the priesthood thanks to the inspiration of his erudite and saintly Uncle Rev. Fr. John O. Egbulefu C.C.E. After Fr. Charles's primary school education at Assumpta Catholic Primary School and Police Children's Primary School respectively, he joined the Sacerdotal Congregation of Christ the Emmanuel (C.C.E.) in 1995, founded by his Uncle Fr. John. He completed 6 years of formation in the Annunciation Minor Seminary Amaudara and then began his Emmanuelite Novitiate formation in 2001 making his first temporal profession of Religious Vows in September 2002.

In October 2002, Fr. Charles began his philosophical formation at the Bigard Memorial Seminary, Enugu, Nigeria, completing them at the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum, Rome, in 2005. In 2007, Fr. Charles did his final profession of his Religious Vows and in 2008 obtained his Bachelor's in theology. In 2010, he obtained his Licentiate degree in Systematic Theology also at the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum, Rome. In 2014, Fr. Charles concluded his theological studies at Pontifical University of Pope Urban VIII, Rome, with a Doctorate thesis title of "The Ecclesiology of Saint Bonaventure in the Second Vatican Council."

While finishing his theological studies in Rome, Fr. Charles was ordained to the Catholic Priesthood on November 19, 2011. Since that time, he has helped as a priest in various parishes in Italy, in the Vatican Sistine Chapel (as Spiritual Chaplain), and finally in Canada at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, Mississauga as an associate pastor. Alongside his pastoral work in the Archdiocese of Toronto, he is also currently teaching in the Diaconate Program at the St. Augustine's Seminary. He is fluent in the following languages: Igbo, English, and Italian. Let us welcome Fr. Charles to our Transfiguration family.




