CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE

The College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario requires physicians to make an “effective referral” for assisted suicide and euthanasia. Many Catholic physicians & other care givers (nurse practitioner & nurses) are unable to assist in good conscience and may be forced to choose between their conscience or their careers. Given the introduction of Bill 84 on medical aid in dying at Queen’s Park in December we have the opportunity to push for amendments to the Bill to include conscience protection for all health care workers. The CWL are asking parishioners to contact their MPPs about this important issue to represent Catholic voices in Ontario. A letter is available to fill out in the vestibule this weekend or in the parish office.
