

CHURCH RENOVATION

We have published the 2017 financial report in our bulletin two weeks ago. Once again, we thank you for all your donation and generosity towards the Transfiguration of Our Lord Parish. Your financial support is very important in operating our parish activity in a smooth manner. Our church is 58 years old and there are many renovation and maintenance that will be coming up. As you all know, we have replaced the boiler in 2016 and recently we have renovated our two meeting rooms in the upper hall.

This year, our plans include renovating the washrooms and other necessary places. At the present time, we would like to renovate two washrooms in the main level. The cost of these two washrooms is worth \$45,000.00.

Through our fundraising thus far, we have raised approximately \$11,000.00.

The Parish Finance Council has decided to have two special collections.

During the first collection we have raised a total of \$4,744.00.

The next collection will be on the weekend of June 9th/10th, 2018.
