If you missed the information meetings and would still like your child to receive First Communion (Gr. 2 & up) or Confirmation (Gr. 7& up), please come to the parish office on Sunday mornings after the 10:30 a.m. & 12:00 Noon Masses to receive information and a registration form.

The Sacramental Preparation program applies to students in one of our parish schools or in local public or private schools.

Registration for First Communion closes October 29th and Confirmation closes this Sunday, October 22nd.

Following registration the Confirmandi are required to come for an interview with Fr. George Parayil.

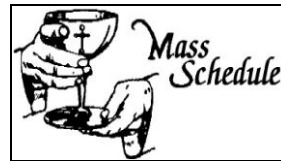
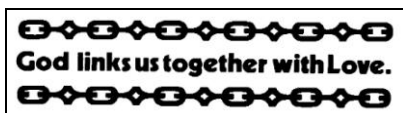
