Registration for First Communion closes October 29th, 2017.

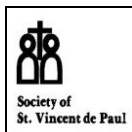

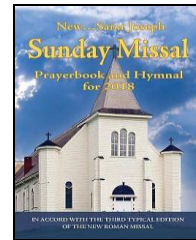


MASS OF HOPE
