The RCIA program for those wishing to become Catholic will begin in October. If you are interested in being a part of this program please call parish office to register at (416)247-0513.





#### MISSION APPEAL FOR THE CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF ZARIA

The aim of participation in the Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) of the Archdiocese of Toronto is to raise awareness of the plight of the vulnerable population in the diocese of Zaria who live on the margin of society, who cannot afford the basic necessities of life such as food, medicine, water and clothing. Through the diocesan office of the Justice and Peace in Zaria, we have identified such families at parish levels and have tried to address their humanitarian concerns. However, the numbers of people in dire economic and social situations are increasing daily because of dwindling family fortunes. The recent onslaught of the extremist Islamic sect, Boko Haram, of Nigeria have exacerbated the problem, with the attainment of the right to food a much more difficult task. Many people continue to flee conflicts zones leaving vast uncultivated lands that had hitherto served as their means of livelihood. The majority of those suffering from hunger and malnutrition are smallholders or landless people, mostly women and girls living in rural areas without access to productive resources. In children, hunger slows physical and mental development and leaves them vulnerable to many preventable diseases such as blindness, diarrhea and respiratory infections while adults become weakened, less creative and imaginative and affect even their offspring as in the case of women who have given birth to unhealthy babies. Malnutrition is an underlying cause in 35% of the 1 million under five deaths that occur in Nigeria every year. Many people are hungry and incapable of meeting their daily dietary needs and food preferences for living an active and healthy lifestyle. A situation where people do not know where the next meal would come from is precarious.

We ask you to come to our aid as we expand the humanitarian service we render to many more who daily hunger and in need of medicine to fight off preventable diseases. Your generosity will not only alleviate the situation of many but will also change their fate from certain starvation to living fruitful and flourishing lives. We look forward to your kind generosity.
