The Sacramental Preparation program applies to students in one of our parish schools or in local public or private schools.

Registration for First Communion closes October 29th and Confirmation closes October 22nd.

Following registration the Confirmandi are required to come for an interview with Fr. George Parayil.

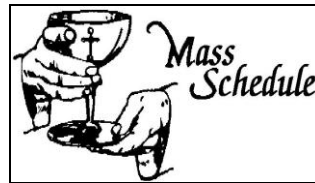
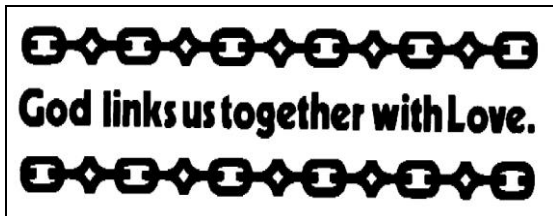
Please sign up in the vestibule to join the group that will recite the rosary in a language of your preference.

SENIORS EXERCISE CLUB

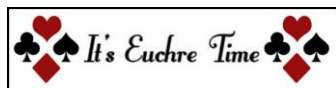
The seniors exercise club has resumed. It takes place every Monday & Wednesday in the parish hall at 10:30 a.m.

SISTINE CHAPEL CHOIR CONCERT

For the first in its history, the Sistine Chapel Choir (commonly known as the Pope's choir) will visit Canada. The first stop of the tour will take place on Tuesday, September 26th at 7:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. This internationally renowned group of 30 boys and 22 men sing for the Holy Father's celebrations at the Vatican and tour the world to share the gift of sacred music. The Sistine Chapel Choir is considered one of the most prominent and oldest choirs in the world dating back to the 17th century. A limited number of free general admission tickets (maximum 2 per person) will be made available on line at: bit.ly/sistineTO beginning Monday September 11th at 10 a.m. The concert will also feature a performance by the students of St. Michael's Choir School, one of only six choir schools in the world affiliated with the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music in Rome.

WHY REGISTER IN THE PARISH?

Often people may attend Mass at a certain parish for several years, but never register. In our society, sometimes a person may feel more comfortable at a particular parish whether or not it is the geographical area where the person lives.

When a pastor accepts the registration, he also accepts the responsibility of their spiritual care.

For instance, if a person was sick or dying, that parish priest has the responsibility for that person.

Parish registration creates a two-fold obligation: on one hand, the pastor is obligated to support the mission and needs of the parish and its

parishioners; on the other hand, the individual takes on the obligation to support the mission and needs of the parish and his/her fellow parishioners.

We strongly encourage you to register, even if you do not wish to receive weekly contribution envelopes. Registering in a parish is a declaration of your desire to be part of a Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of

Transfiguration of Our Lord Parish community.

Being a registered parishioner makes the process much easier when you wish to participate in a parish ministry, or when it is time for infant baptism, school or religious education registration, weddings, when asked to be a baptismal or confirmation sponsor, and even funerals, reference

letters, getting donation statements for tax purposes etc. A registered parishioner receives all parish mailings. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.

Are you registered with us? One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes, newsletters or emails. If you do not receive at least one of these, then perhaps you are not registered here, you may want to check with the parish office staff.

We are so gifted with many wonderful people who have lived parish life in an admirable way! We are so proud of our liturgical ministers, our school and religious education families, our music ministers, the caring people of our parish who work with the bereaved, the sick, our children and teens, all those who participate in the Mass, and sacraments and devotions....and we invite you to be ONE with us!
