Registration for First Communion closes October 28th and Confirmation closes October 14th.

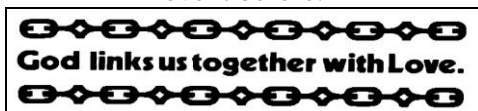
