

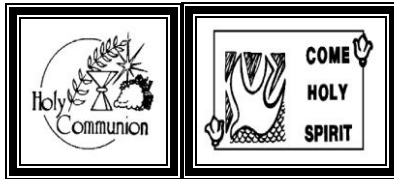


BUNDLE SUNDAY

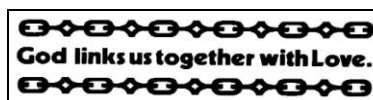

CHURCH PARKING LOT

The cost of repaving is \$135,000.00.

Unfortunately our current financial situation does not allow us to cover the entire cost. The Parish Finance Council and Fr. George have agreed that we will be asking the Archdiocese for a loan of \$142,000.00 due to the fact that we have an outstanding payment to the Archdiocese regarding the church assessment and the cost of the repaving of the parking lot.

The parish would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who contributed to the 5-year Family of Faith campaign which will be ending this Fall season. With the contributions that we have collected, we were able to use a portion of the monies towards the cost of the replacement of the boiler. The remainder will be applied to the cost of the repaving of the parking lot.

We would like to request that you continue using the blue donation envelopes that are available in the vestibule and the parish office. As we have to pay back the loan to the Archdiocese, the council has decided that in 2020, a *weekly blue church maintenance envelope* will be included in the box set of donation envelopes. We would greatly appreciate your assistance and support in this matter. In addition to our weekly blue church maintenance envelopes, we will be also looking at other fundraisers to help pay off the loan. Thank you for generously supporting our parish community.
