The 20th annual National March for Life will
take place in Ottawa, our nation’s capital, on
Thursday, May 11, 2017.

This year’s theme is “Life We Stand on

(just north of Rexdale Blvd.)

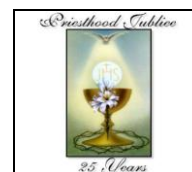
Bus departs at 6:30 a.m.
