

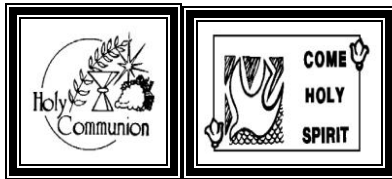
**SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT

Two parent information meetings have been scheduled:

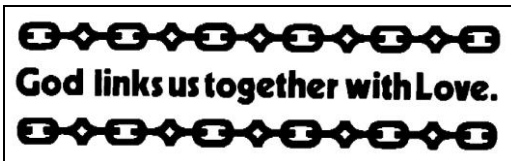
**Monday, September 17th at 7 p.m. and
