Like the light shining in the darkness, that is what gives us the courage to live from day to day in justice and integrity.

I take this opportunity to wish you all a very Happy Christmas and thank you for your support and generosity towards Transfiguration parish. I will be offering Masses for you and for your family members, especially those who are sick or away from home at this time.
