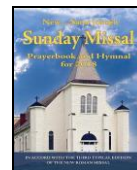
ST. AUGUSTINE SEMINARY PRESENTATION

**Major relic of Saint Francis Xavier to visit the
Archdiocese of Toronto
January 12 – 14, 2018**

A first-degree relic of missionary Saint Francis Xavier is coming to the Archdiocese of Toronto,

January 12-14, 2018. The forearm of the saint, permanently displayed at the Church of the Gesù in Rome, will be in Canada from December 29 – February 2, as part of a 14-city Canadian visit.

In our archdiocese, the relic will be hosted by St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (Jan.12), St. Francis Xavier Church, Miss., (Jan. 13) and Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Toronto (Jan. 14). More information about the visit and a full schedule of events can be found at:
