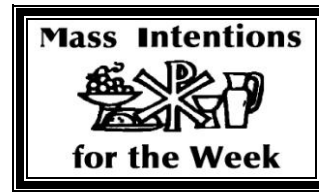

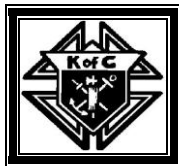

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY 2017

Every year, between January 18th (the Feast of the Confession of St. Peter) and January 25th (the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul), Christians around the world are invited to celebrate a week of prayer for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate in jointly-organized ecumenical services, and to share fellowship. This year's theme is "Reconciliation" - The Love of Christ Compels Us," inspired by 2Corinthians 5:14-20.
