Priest: Fr. Doug Grandon

Fr. Doug became Catholic in 2003, after serving as an Evangelical Protestant Free Church missionary/pastor and Episcopal priest for 25 years. In 2008, Pope Benedict granted

Fr. Doug permission to be ordained Catholic priest. He presently serves as St. Vincent de Paul Church in Denver and teaches Homiletics at St. John Vianney Seminary. Fr. Doug serves as a National Chaplain with FOCUS – the Fellowship of Catholic University Students.

Fr. Doug serves on the board of the Mary Mother of God (Russian) Mission – where nearly 30,000 Catholics suffered martyrdom in the 1920's and 30's.

Fr. Doug holds certificates from the Institute for Foreign Languages in Belgrade, Serbia and degrees from Bradley University, Liberty University, and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. He earned a PhD in Historical Theology from St. Louis University and completed a year of post-doctoral study at Oxford University.
