Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

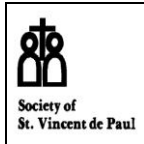

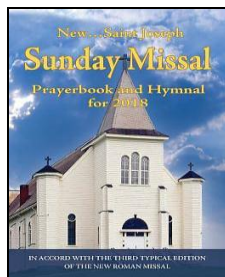
