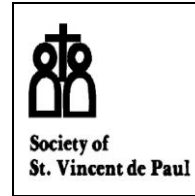

At all Masses on the weekend of Nov. 11th and 12th envelopes will be handed out for our annual Christmas collection. Last year at Christmas we helped 94 families

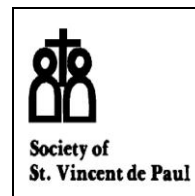
(148 adults and 168 children).

If you would like to sponsor a family, please leave your name and phone number at the parish office and we will get in touch with you. As always your support is greatly appreciated

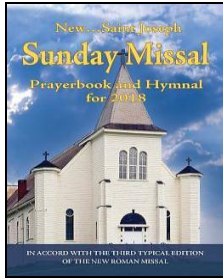
