FR. CARLOS' PRESENTATION

Fr. Carlos Augusto Sierra Tobón, a priest from the Archdiocese of Toronto, originally from Colombia, S.A.

Fr. Carlos was ordained 41 years ago. He has an international background in his studies and from the various places he has worked. His philosophy courses were done in Bogotá, his Theology in the Universities of Javeriana of Bogotá and the Gregorian University of Rome, Italy. Studies in Pastoral Resources at the Universities of Urbaniana and European University of Rome and Instituto Maestro Avila of Salamanca-Spain. Fr. Carlos also has his MA. in Pastoral Counselling at Duquesne University of Pittsburgh, USA.

For a period of seven years, Fr. Carlos was an Executive Secretary with the Colombian Bishops' Conference and the Latin-American Episcopal Conference (CELAM) in Bogotá, Colombia.

Fr. Carlos was a former member of a missionary congregation and has worked as a missionary in Colombia and Tanzania-East Africa.

For the last 19 years he has been with the Archdiocese of Toronto in three different parishes as Pastor. Recently, he was appointed as Pastor of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Church.

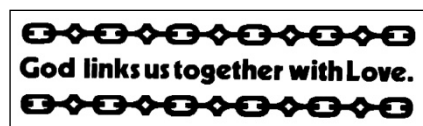
Fr. Carlos has written four books in the field of Youth Ministry and other publications for youth, missionary work and vocation promotion.

FR. JOMON'S PRESENTATION

Fr. Jomon George was born on 9th March 1978 in a small village of Ramapuram, Kerala. His parents are George and Aleyamma. He has one brother and a sister. He joined the

Religious Order of the Missionaries of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary founded by St. Gaetano Errico when he was 15 years old. He was ordained to the priesthood on the 7th January 2006 by His Excellency Joseph Pallickaparambil Bishop Emeritus of Palai Diocese, Kerala.

After the Ordination in 2006 he was sent to Rome to do the Licentiate in Sacred Theology of Matrimony and Family at the Pontifical Lateran University. In the year 2008 he was sent to Nigeria by the Superior General of the Congregation as formator of the seminarians. In 2010 he was sent to the Indonesian Mission as Novice Master for the seminarians. In the 2012 he was asked by the superior General of the congregation to go to Colombia (South America) to start a religious community there, In Colombia he served as the Delegate Superior of the religious order and from 2017 to 2019 he was appointed as pastor of Our Lady of Sorrows parish in Bogota, Colombia. From 2019 to 2020 he was in the United States to help the priests of their religious order in their pastoral ministry. On 27th August 2020 he was officially appointed as the Associate Pastor of St. Thomas Aquinas Parish, North York. Currently he is appointed as the Associate Pastor of Transfiguration of our Lord Parish, Etobicoke.
