**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Today's Gospel reading directly follows last week's Gospel in which Jesus taught the disciples how to handle disputes and conflict within the Christian community. In today's reading Peter asks Jesus how many times one ought to extend forgiveness to another. Peter proposes a reasonable number of times, perhaps seven. Jesus replies by extending Peter's proposal by an enormous amount; not just seven times should one forgive, but 77 times. The parable of the unforgiving servant is Jesus' elaboration of his initial reply to Peter. Through the parable we come to understand the depths of God's mercy toward us and the results of our acceptance of God's forgiveness.

In the parable the king's forgiveness is like God's forgiveness, and it transforms us, helping us to be as forgiving as God. The lesson is clear: If we hoard God's mercy while showing no mercy to others, we risk forfeiting the effects of God's mercy in our lives. (Sunday Connection-Loyola Press)

**MEDITAZIONE SPIRITUALE**

**Impariamo a Perdonare** - Sì, dobbiamo perdonare i nostri fratelli senza misura, perché Dio ci ha già fatti oggetto, in Gesù Cristo, di un perdono unilaterale e senza misura (cf Rm 5, 6-10). E, inversamente, possiamo chiedere perdono al Signore solo nella misura in cui siamo disposti a perdonare i nostri «con-servi». Ecco perché nel «Padre nostro» la richiesta di perdono da noi rivolta a Dio è condizionata dalla nostra pratica di perdono verso gli altri. Non a caso l'unica domanda di questa preghiera che Gesù spiega è: «rimetti a noi i nostri debiti come anche noi li rimettiamo ai nostri debitori» (cf Mt 6,12), e lo fa con parole che dobbiamo ricordare: «Se voi infatti perdonerete agli altri le loro colpe, il Padre vostro che è nei cieli perdonerà anche a voi; ma se voi non perdonerete agli altri, neppure il Padre vostro perdonerà le vostre colpe» (cf Mt 6, 14-15).

Ebbene, il perdono è la vera vittoria sul male. Impariamo a perdonare perché, come disse Papa Pio XII: «L'avvenire appartiene a quelli che amano, a quelli che perdonano, non a quelli che odiano, perché il male si vince col bene; questo è il comandamento di Dio». (Lucio D'Abbraccio)
